Winzerwald's German History

Winzerwald Winery celebrates the owners' joint German family heritage with its wines, gifts & events. Winzerwald is German for "vintners of the forest". The name honors the family's German heritage and the Swiss & German heritage of the southern Indiana Uplands & Perry County. Both Dan and Donna come from families of winemakers. Dan's great great grandfather Peter Loesch was a commercial winemaker and cooper (wine barrel craftsman) and Donna's father Frank Mittelstadt was a home wine-maker. Grandpa Loesh was said to be able to change a barrel stave in a full barrel of wine without losing a drop of wine!

A limited edition wine called Heirloom is made from grapes that family lore says were brought to the US by the owner's ancestors when they emigrated from Germany. Experts in the field of viticulture have been unable to identify the grape variety. Try this one-of-a-kind wine made from the family's German mystery grape that still grows in the 5th generation vineyard along the banks of the Ohio River.

Nutcrackers are truly a southern Germany favorite and were therefore chosen as the winery's logo and label design. Nutcrackers also crack nuts from the forest reflecting the winery's location in the Hoosier National Forest.

Winzerwald's special wines include German favorites such as Indiana's first Mai Wine (May Wine) and Glühwein (red spiced wine), Glacier Vidal (wine made similar to the traditional German ice wine) our version of Liebfraumilch which we call Lieblich, Schillerwein (field blended Rosé), Schweizer Spice (we

call it “liquid pumpin pie”), Lemberger, Riesling, Black Riesling (Pinot Meunier), Grauburgunder (Pinot Grigio), Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir), Traminette and Gewürztraminer and a selection of fruit forward fruit and grape wines that rival any (Cranberry, Strawberry, Blueberry, Cherry and more).
